QUALIFYING REQUIREMENTS:

1) TECHNICAL:

- The Bidder should be a BWSSB registered Class-1 contractor and the registration certificate issued by BWSSB should be valid as on date of submission of the bid. Supporting documents shall be enclosed.
- Should have executed satisfactorily under a single contract in any one of the preceding three years (2004-05, 2005-06 & 2006-07), the work of laying 100 mm dia and above DI/CI/MS water supply line for a minimum length of 400 meters in BBMP area. Supporting document shall be enclosed.
- Should have a qualified Engineer having 3 years experience in doing BWSSB works (client certificate shall be furnished).

(2) FINANCIAL:

- Solvency certificate from a Nationalized/Schedule “A” Bank for a value not less than Rs. 20 Lakhs (Rs. Twenty lakhs only). Further, the solvency certificate should not be dated earlier than one month from the date of submission of the tender.
- Shall have executed works worth 25 lakhs in total in the last three years in 2004-05, 2005-06 & 2006-07. Supporting documents shall be enclosed.

Tender documents can be obtained from **20-11-2007 to 10-12-2007** during the office working days and hours on payment of tender document cost as mentioned above in the table in form of **DD drawn in favour of Bangalore Metro Rail Corporation Limited (BMRCL), payable at Bangalore** along with a requisition letter. Completed tender document is received on **15-12-2007** up to 15.00 hours. Technical Bid will be opened on the same day at 15.30 hrs in the presence of the available tenderers. Pre-bid meeting will be held on 10-12-2007 at 15.00 hrs.

SECTION – I

INVITATION OF BIDS

- A.** SEALED tenders in the manner prescribed herein are invited by the Managing Director, Bangalore Metro Rail Corporation Limited (hereinafter referred to as BMRCL), III Floor, BMTC Complex, K.H. Road, Shantinagar, Bangalore-560027, from the reputed and experienced bidders with pre-qualifying requirements as stipulated for the following works under local competitive bid on total turnkey basis for relocation of affected BWSSB utilities for Bangalore Metro Rail Project.

The Scope of the work covers the following:

- i) Providing alternate water supply lines to BWSSB lines interfering with the alignment of Bangalore Metro Rail Project
- ii. The Scope of work shall include procurement of materials, arranging, witnessing of routine/ acceptance/ type tests by the BMRCL representative and also execution testing as per specifications, packing, forwarding, supply of equipments and materials at site including insurance and transportation charges, erection, testing at site and commissioning on total turnkey basis.

Bids not covering the entire specified scope shall be treated as incomplete and rejected.

BMRCL reserves the right to alter the BOQ without assigning any reason what so ever and it also reserves the right to include further conditions during the course of execution of works which would be equally binding on the contractor.

- B.** The Prices shall be firm throughout the Tender period and no escalation will be payable on any amount on any count.
- C.** The Interested eligible bidders may obtain further clarification from the BMRCL.
- D.** A complete set of bid documents may be purchased by interested bidders on the submission of written application to, The Managing Director, BMRCL, III Floor, BMTC Complex, K.H. Road, Shantinagar, Bangalore- 560027, upon payment of non-refundable fee of Rs. 3000/- as described below, in the form of Demand Draft, drawn in favour of the Managing Director, BMRCL, payable at Bangalore. The documents will be sold during the Office hours on all working days and during working hours from **20-11-2007** to **10-12-2007** (both days inclusive).
- E.** Completely filled Bids will be received in this office from 10.30 hours to 15.00 hours IST on **15-12-2007**. The Technical bids will be opened on the same day in the presence of the bidder or his authorized representatives who choose to attend at the office of BMRCL at the above-mentioned address from 1530 Hours. If the due date for opening of Bid happens to be a holiday for BMRCL, the Bid will be opened on the next working day at the same time. BMRCL will not be responsible for any delay/non-delivery of documents by due date due to postal delay.

- F.** The BMRCL reserves the right to evaluate the tender based on the professional competence, nature of work in which experience has been gained, financial standing, organization and supervisory staff and past proven performance in Public Sector Enterprise or Government Departments. The evaluation by the BMRCL of the reputation of the bidder shall be final and no dispute shall be raised or entertained by BMRCL.
- G.** Bidders should, in their own interest, study the scope of work, scheme, drawings and specifications etc. and acquaint themselves with the site conditions, nature and scope of work, besides visiting the site/place of work.
- H.** The Bidder shall be deemed, to have examined the tender document, satisfied himself of the adequacy of information, data etc. and known the scope and magnitude of work.
- I.** It will be presumed that bidder has visited and seen the site at which the work is to be executed and that tender is based on full knowledge of the working conditions prevailing at the site and locality, nature, availability of labour, material, transportation facilities, probable site of camp, site office, stores etc., and all other factors involved in the execution of the work.
- J.** The Bidder shall be deemed to have satisfied himself to the condition of all existing structures, if any, and also have made local independent enquiries, and all other similar matters affecting the work. He is deemed to have acquainted himself as to his liability for payment of taxes, levies, custom duty and other charges. Any information on any matter derived from these documents, including drawings and specifications as obtained from the BMRCL shall not absolve or relieve the bidder from fulfilling all the terms and conditions of the contract, including execution of all work(s) which shall also cover incidental work(s) though not expressly mentioned in the tender document, but which, whether temporary or permanent, must evidently be required by reasons of the nature of the work included in the contract.
- K.** Bids shall be accompanied by EMD in the form of Demand Draft as mentioned against EMD column of each enquiry. The EMD shall cover the entire validity period of the bid including period of extension if any required by BMRCL.
- L.** Bids comprising of Technical Bid & Price bid shall be submitted in duplicate in the prescribed format only in separate sealed covers both enclosed in an outer sealed cover.
- M.** The Technical bids would be opened first and evaluated for qualification and the Price bids of technically qualified bidders would be opened on an informed date. During the Price bid opening total Prices of the bids would only be read out.
- N.** The Bid security as EMD and qualifying requirement data are provided below. The bidder shall provide credentials in support of the technical capacity, financial strength and past experience, failing which the bids will be disqualified.
- O.** BMRCL takes no responsibility for delay, loss or non-receipt of bid document sent by post / courier /either way. Further BMRCL reserves the right to reject any or all the bids without assigning any reasons thereof and shall bear no liability whatsoever consequent upon such a decision.

P. QUALIFICATION REQUIREMENTS

1) TECHNICAL:

- i) The Bidder should be a BWSSB registered Class-1 contractor and the registration certificate issued by BWSSB should be valid as on date of submission of the bid. Supporting document shall be enclosed.
- ii) Should have executed satisfactorily under a single contract in any one of the preceding three years (2004-05, 2005-06 & 2006-07), the work of laying 100 mm dia and above DI/CI/MS water supply line for a minimum length of 400 meters in BBMP area. Supporting document shall be enclosed.
- iii) Should have a qualified Engineer having 3 years experience in doing BWSSB works (client certificate shall be furnished).

(2) FINANCIAL:

- i) Solvency certificate from a Nationalized/Schedule "A" Bank for a value not less than Rs. 20 Lakhs (Rs. Twenty lakhs only). Further, the solvency certificate should not be dated earlier than one month from the date of submission of the tender. Supporting document shall be enclosed.
- ii) Shall have executed works worth Rs. 25 lakhs in total in the last three years in 2004-05, 2005-06 & 2006-07. Supporting document shall be enclosed.

The Bidder shall furnish documentary evidence in support of all the qualifying requirements stipulated in clause P (1) & P (2) above.

R. FAITH IN ISSUE OF BID FORMS

Bid documents will be issued to Bidders on the strength of their claim in good faith. However such issue of Bid document will not automatically mean that Bidders are considered qualified. Such qualification will be reviewed again at the time of the evaluation of the bids. Intending parties who fulfill the qualifying requirements are advised to visit the sites to familiarize themselves with the nature and quantum of works & site conditions.

S. WORK COMPLETION PERIOD:

Time is the essence of this contract. Period of completion is 90 days from the date of issue of Letter of Acceptance (LOA) and such issue of Letter of Acceptance will be treated as deemed date of commencement of work.

SECTION – II

INSTRUCTIONS TO TENDERERS

1. Study the Bid form carefully & submit the same duly signed on each page.
2. The Bid is a two part bid, Technical and Price. On the specified bid opening day the technical bid will be opened. The opening of Price bid would be intimated later to the technically qualified bidders for Price bid opening.
3. The Earnest Money Deposit (EMD) shall be furnished by a Demand Draft, drawn in favour of Managing Director; BMRCL along with the Bid, other wise the Bid shall be rejected. The EMD in any other form is not acceptable.
4. Corrections in the Bid shall be strictly avoided & all the corrections shall be duly attested.
5. The bid is a percentage bid, the total amount mentioned on the Price Bid Sheet (PBS) will only be considered for the Price Bid evaluation. The place where price has to be quoted has been clearly marked.

NOTE: The BOQ sheets are only for reference of the tenderer and he shall not mention any rates on these items.

6. The rates quoted shall be stated in words as well as in figures clearly. In case of a mismatch, rates in words will be taken as final. If any mismatch is found in the original & duplicate, then rates in the original shall prevail.
7. The top cover and all other covers / envelopes pertaining to the Bids shall be superscribed with Tender Notification No, Name of the work. & due date of opening.
8. Bids shall be submitted in three separate sealed covers, one for EMD, one for Technical and one for Price bid. These three sealed covers shall be enclosed in one outer sealed envelop and super scribed with the name of the work and Tender notification number.
9. The inner envelopes containing EMD, Technical Bid and the Price Bid shall be clearly superscribed as “EMD”, “TECHNICAL BID” & “PRICE BID”
 - (i) The first cover contains only the EMD prescribed.
 - (ii) The Technical and Price Bids shall be submitted in duplicate. The main Technical and Price Bid envelopes shall consist of two sealed sub envelopes, one for original super scribed, “Original Bid” and another for copy (Duplicate) super scribed “Duplicate Bid”.
 - (iii) The sealed cover super scribed “**Technical bid original**” shall contain
 - a) Criteria for qualifying requirement and bidder shall furnish all the supporting documents (Including the BWSSB registration certificate).
 - b) Signed original document for having read and understood the conditions.

- (iv) The sealed cover superscribed "**Technical bid duplicate**" shall contain Copies of all the documents in the sealed cover of **Technical bid original**.
- (v) The sealed cover superscribed "**Price bid Original**" shall contain
 - a) Original Price bid duly quoting the prices and signed on all the pages.
 - b) Discount offer if any in a separate letter.
- 10. The sealed cover superscribed "**Price bid duplicate**" shall contain Copies of all the documents in the sealed cover of **Price bid original**.
- 11. Price offer as per price bid shall be "**all inclusive** (Taxed, Cess etc., also)" and no extra cost / charges are payable under any circumstances. Bidder is deemed to have quoted the prices after proper preliminary survey of the different places where the works are to be carried out and after duly considering all aspects and in particular but not limited to weather condition, soil condition, labour availability etc., which can have a bearing on the price of work or time of completion of the works.
- 12. To avoid delay in postal transit, please ensure that the Bids are posted well ahead so as to reach this office within the due date, as the Bids received late will be rejected and will not be considered under any circumstances. BMRCL shall in no way be responsible for such delays.
- 13. Bid forms are not transferable.
- 14. Cost of Bid Document once sold cannot be refunded under any circumstances.
- 15. It may be noted that Telegraphic / Fax quotations & offers will not be accepted.
- 16. Tenderers are advised to retain a copy of the completed Bid document.
- 17. If it is found at any time during the tendering process or even after award of contract that the bidder has submitted any forged documents regarding pre-qualifying requirements, the BMRCL reserves to initiate strict action against such tenderer and the contract will be liable for termination all at the sole risk and cost of the bidder.
- 18. The BMRCL and tenderer submitting a tender offer shall comply with these conditions of tender and in their dealings with each other discharge their duties and obligations timeously and with integrity, and behave equitably, honestly and transparently.
- 19. The Bidder shall not indulge in any corrupt practices. Corrupt Practices means the offering, giving, receiving or soliciting of anything of value to influence the action of the Employer or his staff or agents in the tender process. Any such practices will be viewed seriously and the tender will be liable for rejection, besides, the BMRCL reserves the right to initiate criminal proceedings against such bidders.

20. The Bidder shall not resort to any fraudulent practice. Fraudulent Practice means a misrepresentation of the facts in order to influence the tender process or the execution of a contract arising from a tender offer to the detriment of the Employer, including collusive practices intended to establish prices at artificial levels. Any such practices will be viewed seriously and the tender will be liable for rejection, besides, the BMRCL reserves the right to initiate criminal proceedings against such bidders.
21. Any effort by a tenderer to influence the BMRCL or Engineer or Authorised Officer in the process of examination, clarification, evaluation and comparison of tenders and in decisions concerning award of contract, may result in the rejection of the bid.
22. Canvassing in any form in connection with this bid is strictly prohibited and the bid of the bidder found to indulge in such canvassing will be rejected and no correspondence will be entertained.
23. The pre bid meeting of interested bidders will be held on 10-12-2007 at 15.00 hrs in BMRCL office.

Extract from 18.6 (a) of Section – IV – Terms and Conditions

*“18.6(a) **Mobilisation Advance:** Mobilisation Advance upto maximum of Rs. 8.0 lakhs for Package-1 and Rs. 9.0 lakhs for Package-2 will be paid to the contractor at the rate of 10% interest per annum against the Bank Guarantee from a nationalized bank. The mobilization advance together with the interest will be recovered from the first bill onwards of the contractor in proportion to the value of the work done”.*
