Our only concern is that the roads are already cramped and unable to handle the Traffic, under these circumstances the proposed Elevated Metro will further occupy lot of space on the road during the process of implementation, the traffic jam will be further aggravated increasing the travel time minimum by additional hour one way, which in essence means two more hours on the road every day. This would be over and above the noise & air pollution and wastage of fuel & time.


