In between the said junction the Metro Rail proceeds with B Narayanapura, Mahadevapura, Singayanapalya, Garudacharpalya, Boruka Techpark, Graphite India via EPIP Zone and proceeding further to Pattandur Agrahara, ITPL and Whitefield.

For the reasons best known the said train is not made to pass through Hoody village which is situated around 1 Km from Boruka Techpark and 4 Kms from Whitefield. The population of Hoody village is about 1,50,000 compared to other villages in the neighbourhood with lesser population. There are innumerable residential apartments and residences confining to Hoody village and other neighbouring village such as Basava Nagar, Rajapalya, Thigalarapalya, Shanthinagar, Kodigehalli, Sadarmanagala, and Ayyappanagar and as such in the interest and convenience of public commuters the present memorandum is made to extend and make provision for setting up a Metro station at Hoody village where Government land is available abundantly for setting up the Metro station and other infrastructures. 

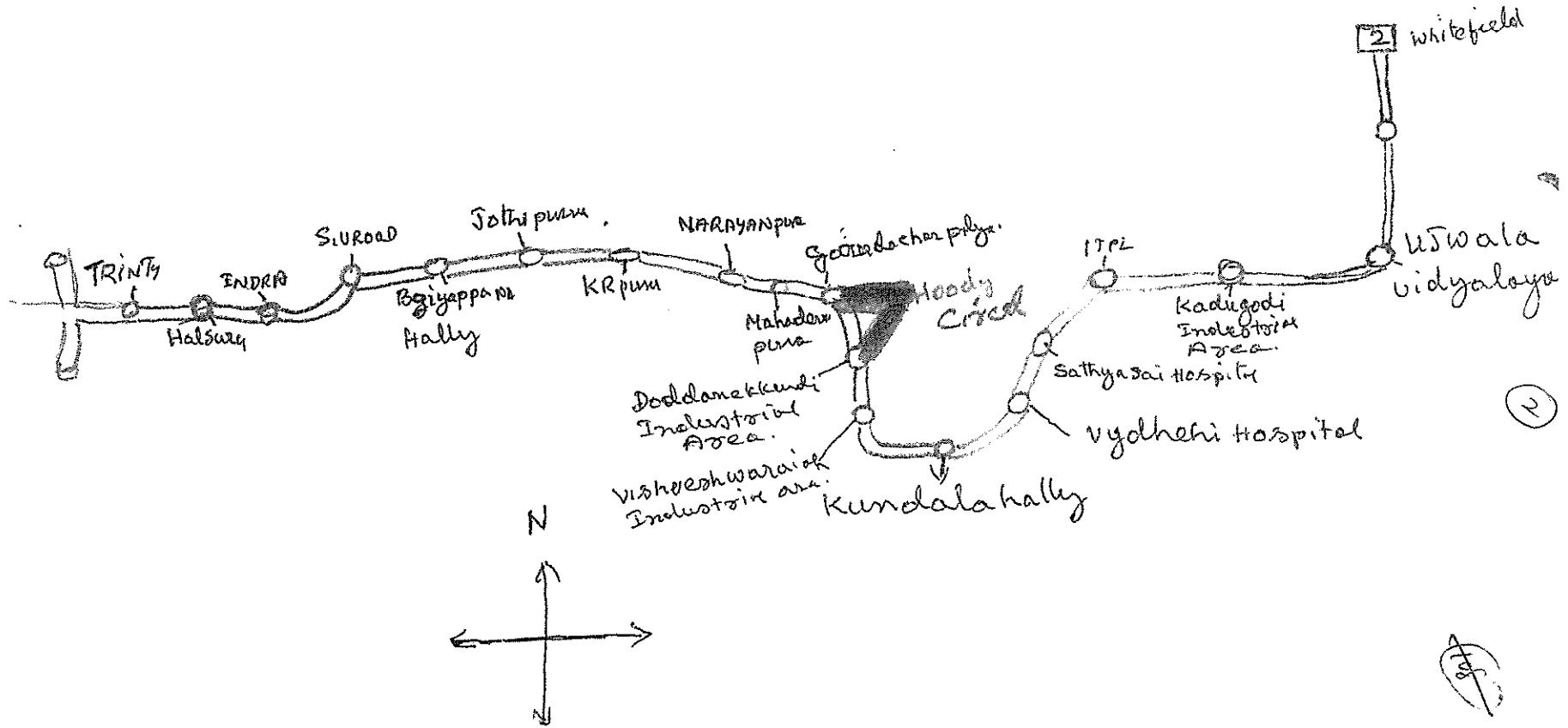
