

BANGALORE METRO RAIL CORPORATION LIMITED**NOTICE INVITING TENDER****NO. BMRCL/CEE (Ph-II)/ELE-36/Tender/2015-16/****Dated:29/03/2016**

BANGALORE METRO RAIL CORPORATION LIMITED invites sealed bids from the experienced and eligible bidders for the works mentioned below under local competitive bid on total turnkey basis for "Increasing the height of existing 220 KV Peenya-Singarpur Single Circuit (SC) line and Peenya-Somanahally Single Circuit (SC) line so as to obtain required vertical clearance and to facilitate construction of Viaduct by BMRCL in Reach-2 Extension between Nayandahalli to Kengeri"

- A. The Scope of the work covers the following:
- Increasing the height of existing 220KV SC Towers.
 - Concreting of new 220 KV SC Narrow base Towers by the side of /next to the existing Towers as per the survey report.
 - Releasing of the conductor, Dismantling of Existing Towers.
 - Erection of new Towers, Restranging of conductor and commissioning.
 - Dynamometer should be utilized for stringing of conductor by giving proper tension.
- B. Bids not covering the entire specified scope shall be treated as incomplete and rejected. It is a fixed price contract.
- C. The Interested eligible bidders may obtain further information on BMRCL site www.bmrc.co.in. The bid documents would be available on prescribed payment from – **30/03/2016 to 28/04/2016** during office working hours.
- D. A complete set of non transferable bid documents on payment of non-refundable fee of INR 5,000/- (Indian Rupees five thousand only) in the form of DD/pay order in favour of BMRCL, payable at Bangalore by sending a request through highlighting in case of any difficulty or clarifications the same can be obtained from the Chief Engineer Electrical (Phase-II), BMRCL, III Floor, BMTCL Complex, K.H.Road, Shanthinagar, Bangalore-560 027 on all working days during the working hours till the last date of sale of documents.
- E. Completed Bids shall be submitted along with the EMD in the form of Demand Draft as mentioned against EMD column. The EMD shall cover the entire validity period of the bid including period of extension if any, required by BMRCL.
- F. Bids shall be submitted in 3 sealed envelopes / covers separately for viz. (i) The EMD (ii) Technical Bid and (iii) Price Bid, both technical & Price bids shall be in duplicate in separate sealed covers. All the three shall be enclosed in an outer sealed cover.
- G. Bids will be received from **11:00 hours to 15.00 hours on 28/04/2016**. The technical bids will be opened in the presence of the bidder or his authorized representative who choose to attend, at the office of BMRCL on **28/04/2016 from 15.30 Hrs**. If the office happens to be closed on the last day of issue or receipt of the bids for any reason, the bids will be issued or received and opened on the next working day of the office at the same venue and time.
- H. The Price bids of technically qualified bidders will be opened at a later date under intimation to such bidders only in the presence of bidders/representatives who choose to be present.

Bid security of bidders not technically qualified will be returned through registered post only after award of the contract to the successful bidder.

- I. The bidder shall provide credentials in support of the qualifying criteria, technical capability, financial strength and past experience by supporting documents / client certificates / CA's audit reports.
- J. BMRCL takes no responsibility for delay, loss or non-receipt of bid document sent by post / courier /either way. Further, BMRCL reserves the right to reject any or all the bids without assigning any reasons thereof and shall bear no liability whatsoever consequent upon such a decision.

K. Financial/Technical Eligibility Criteria for Bidders:

1. The Bidder should have a valid "Super Grade Electrical License" issued by the Electrical Inspectorate, Government of Karnataka. Attested copy of the License shall be furnished. Original Document of the license will have to be produced for verification by BMRCL after opening of the Technical bid as requested.
2. The bidder should have experience in construction of 220 KV or 66 KV overhead transmission lines with narrow based/ regular towers concreting and erection, stringing and commissioning during the last five years ending 31.12.2015 as detailed below:
 - i) The bidder should have executed and completed at least one similar work during the last five years ending 31.12.2015, of value not less than INR 73,30,000/- (Indian Rupees Seventy Three lakhs Thirty thousand only). The Bidder shall furnish client's certificates in support of the same.

OR

- ii) The bidder should have executed and completed at least two similar works during the last five years ending 31.12.2015, each of value not less than INR 58,64,000/- (Indian Rupees Fifty eight lakhs Sixty four thousand only). The Bidder shall furnish Client's certificates in support of the same.

OR

- iii) The bidder should have executed and completed at least three similar works during the last five years ending 31.12.2015, each of value not less than INR 43,98,000/- (Indian Rupees Forty Three lakhs Ninety Eight thousand only). The Bidder shall furnish client's certificates in support of the same.
3. The bidder should have an average annual turnover during the last three financial years ending 31.03.2015 not less than INR 1,83,25,000/- (Indian Rupees one crore Eighty Three lakhs twenty five thousand only).
4. The Bidder should not have been black listed by any government department/Public Sector Undertakings (PSU). The Bidder should furnish a declaration to that effect.
5. The Bidder should not have history of litigation and should not have been black listed by KPTCL / BESCO or erstwhile KEB or by any department of Government of Karnataka

and any other Central Government department including PSUs. An undertaking to that effect shall be furnished.

- L. The Bidder shall furnish copies of audited and certified financial reports in support of the same, for the financial years 2012-13, 2013-14 and 2014-15.
- M. The Bidder shall furnish documentary evidence in support of the qualifying requirements stipulated above.
- N. Issue of Bid document will not automatically mean that Bidders are considered qualified, and it is subject to evaluation by BMRCL. Intending parties who fulfill the qualifying requirements are advised to visit the site to familiarize themselves with the nature of work & site conditions.
- O. Late Tenders, received after stipulated time of submission of bid on the specified date, shall not be accepted under any circumstances.
- P. Tenders shall be valid for a period of 90 days from the latest date of submission of Tenders and shall be accompanied with a Earnest Money Deposit (EMD) of the requisite amount in the form of a Demand draft or Pay Order or Bank Guarantee described in paragraph 16.0 of the Instructions to Tenderers.
- Q. A firm after purchase of the Tender documents in their name can submit the Tender.
- R. BMRCL reserves the right to accept or reject any/all tenders without assigning any reasons. Tenderer shall not have any cause of action or claim against BMRCL for rejection of his Tender.
