The tender documents are available as shown above on payment of a non-refundable fee of **Rs. 15,000 (Rupees fifteen thousand only)** in the form of a crossed Demand draft issued by an Indian Scheduled Bank (excluding Co-operative Banks) or from a Scheduled Foreign Bank as defined in Section 2(e) of RBI Act 1934 read with Second Schedule drawn in favour of 'Bangalore Metro Rail Corporation Limited', payable at Bangalore.
2. Tenderers are hereby cautioned that tenders containing any deviation from contractual terms, conditions, specifications and other requirements, same as provided for in "Instructions to Tenderers" and/or minor deviation without quoting the cost of withdrawal shall be considered as non-responsive and shall be liable for rejection.
3. The Tenderer has to submit the Tender security, Pre Qualification, Technical and Financial documents in separate envelopes. Within the main envelope, there will be four envelopes, first containing Tender Security, second containing PQ document, third containing Technical document and fourth containing Financial documents. In case they are not separated/sealed properly, the bid of the said tenderer shall be summarily rejected. The Tender Security Envelope will be opened first and checked for its adequacies and acceptance. If it is acceptable, the PQ documents envelope shall be opened later. The Financial package will be kept in a sealed condition and placed in a secured place by BMRCL.
4. Applicant must not have been blacklisted or deregistered by any govt. agency or public sector undertaking during last five years. Also the applicant must not have resigned after award of a contract. The Tenderer has to submit the undertaking in this regard in PQ documents.
5. Joint Ventures are restricted to two members only.
6. Tenders shall be valid for a period of 120 days from the date of submission of Tenders.
7. It may be clearly understood and noted that the Tenders for S &G 5&6 are invited separately. The Tenderers can participate for both tenders. However, award of more than one Tender to a Tenderer will be at the discretion of BMRCL and will depend on the capacity and financial soundness of the Tenderer as judged by BMRCL to carry out simultaneously works of this magnitude. If a single tenderer becomes L1 in both tenders, he shall be considered only if the tenderer's average turnover and machinery are equal or more of what is suggested in PQ documents of both tenders. BMRCL decision is final and binding in the regard.
8. One set of tender documents consisting of PQ package, Technical package and Financial package shall be issued. The tender documents are to be submitted un-tampered, duly signed and stamped on each page.
9. Please note carefully the requirements for submitting tenders, and the date and time for submittal. The Tenders must be received in the office of BMRCL at the address specified above, not later than the date and time noted in Key Details referred above.

10. BMRCL requires that bidders should observe highest standard of ethics during the Tender and execution of contracts. BMRCL will reject a proposal for award if it determines that the bidder recommended for award has engaged in corrupt or fraudulent practices while competing for the present contract.
